

I love maths and finding 1 more and 1 less when singing number songs. My favourite is 5 elephants.


I learnt how to make

I loved learning about Diwali and dressing up in traditional clothes and celebrating with my friends.




We learnt lots of facts about vertebrates and invertebrates' animals. We also learnt about animation in computing, we created a flip book.

> We learnt about how important spines are and different parts of human skeleton. We also focused on different ways to be compassionate. I know the Roman numerals now.


We looked at simile poem and shape poem for our poetry competition. We learnt about Maps and using maps in Geography.
