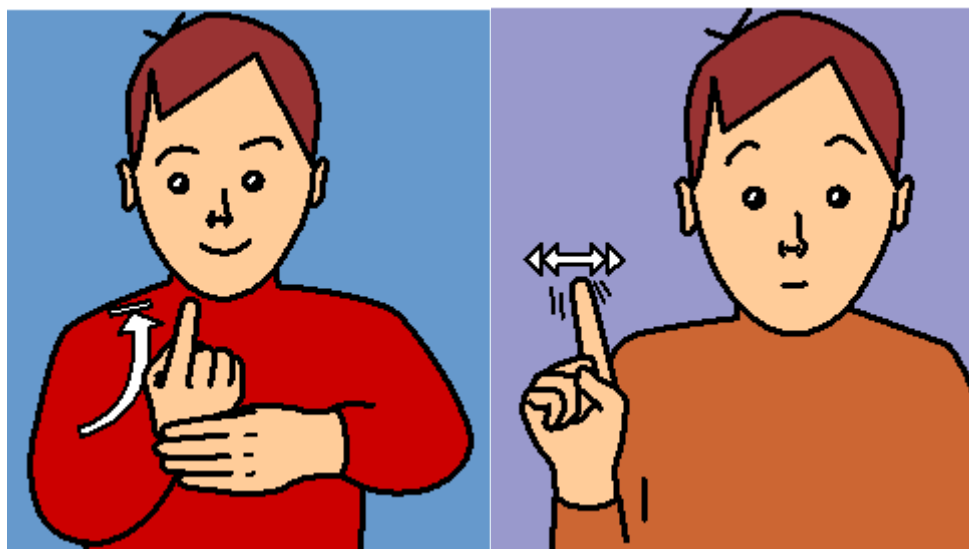

What's Happened: Autumn B 2023

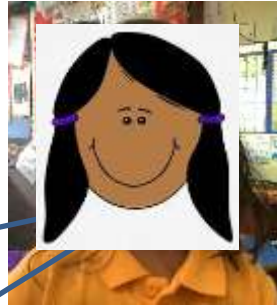
Foundation Dinosaurs
