- Please do keep in touch with us. We would love to see photos of children's work, which we will upload to our showcase page and pupils section on the front page of the website. They will love to have their moment of glory online and it will really be great for children to see their friends as well. As usual, we would never publish the child's name online, please be assured of that.
- Also, have you seen the Joe Wicks 9:00am PE Slot? This will be great for the children. I had heard the RAD might be doing a signed version and I will let you know if I track it down.
- We are creating resources for sign graphics and we are happy to create vocabulary resources for you around any theme. Please just send your teachers a list of the vocab you want and we can do the rest.
