




#### Year 3 Flamingos



I liked ordering pictures from small to big.




I liked making an apple crumble in DT.

I love acting in Red Riding Hood and Jack and the Beanstalk. I like doing our class run outside.


#### **Year 5 Toucans**

I enjoyed learning gymnastic skills. I was proud of my balancing and learning to hoola hoop!




It was exciting learning about money, and making a product to sell at the Christmas Fair.
