New website...

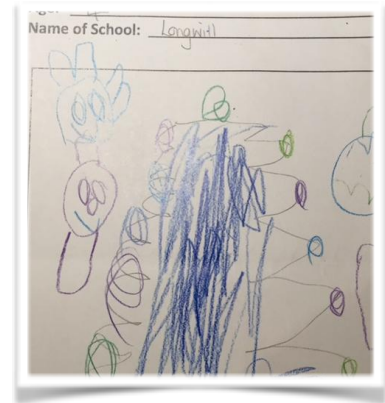
We have a new look website full of information about school life. It has the same web address as before. Please do take a look!
